Testimonial

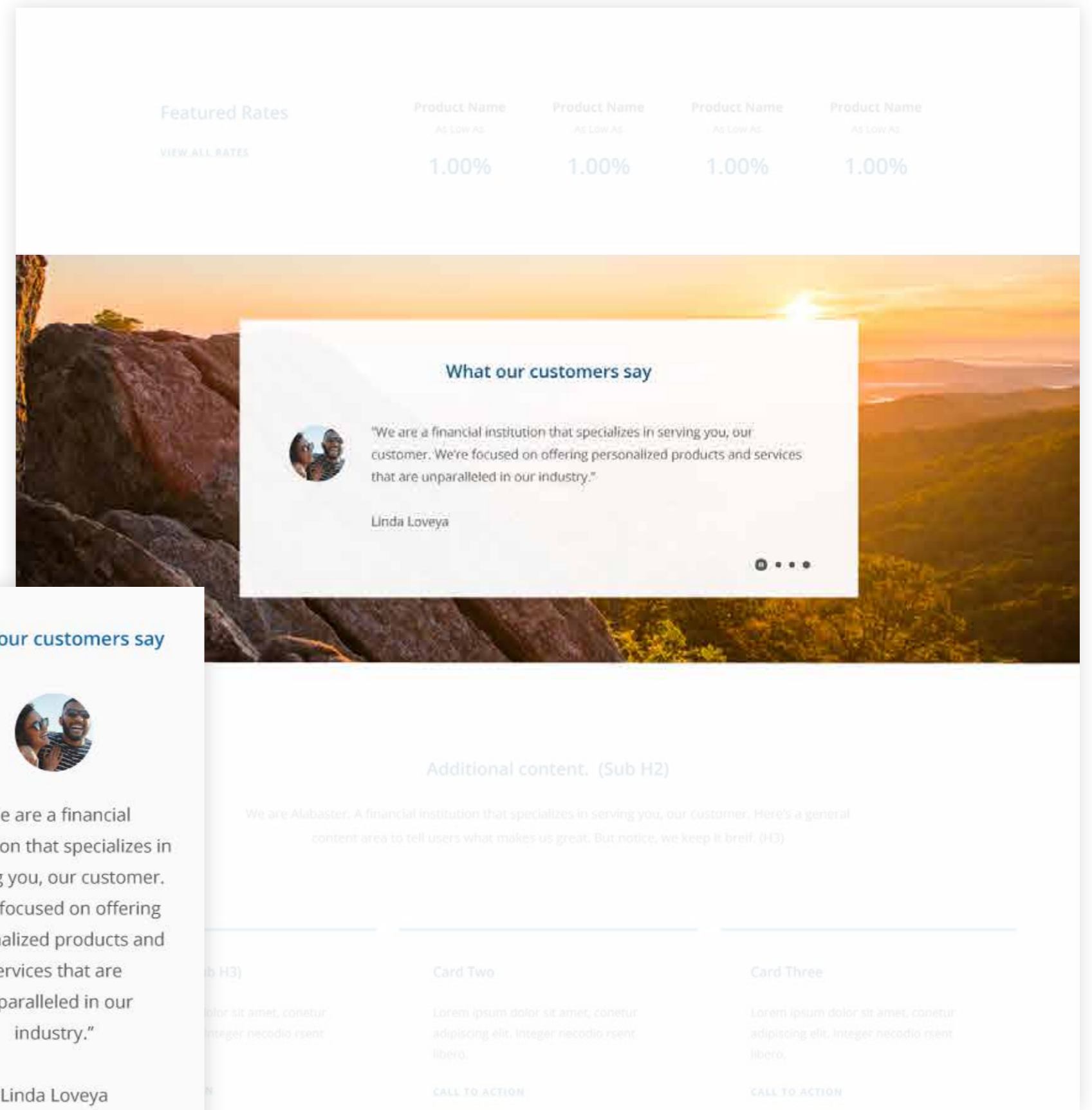
Cell, Grouping

A small component designed to add a touch of validation to the institution. Now a days, People look for reviews to sway them on a decision. Rates

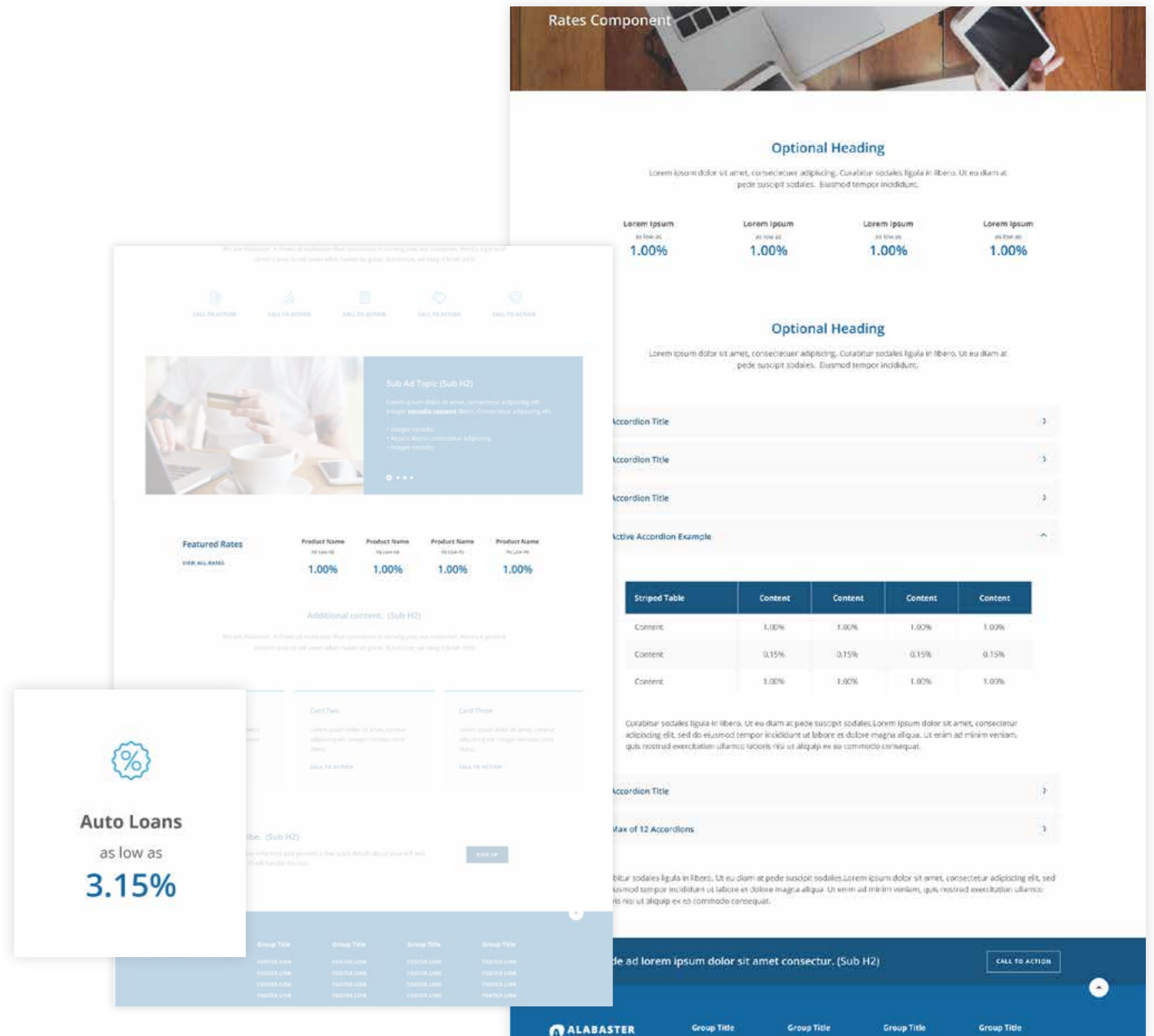
Cell, Grouping, Page

The perfect solution for an FI that is focused on displaying rates. Groupings/cells have the option to include an icon asset and can show up to 4 rates per grouping. Feature rates on the homepage using a grouping while cells are used to feature a single rate on a specific subpage. The Rates page will organize feature rates and rate tables. Tables built with the table builder tool will fit into the accordions while still having a section to highlight featured rates at the top of the page.

- Max 4 featured rates on subpage
- Max 20 accordions on subpage

Modal

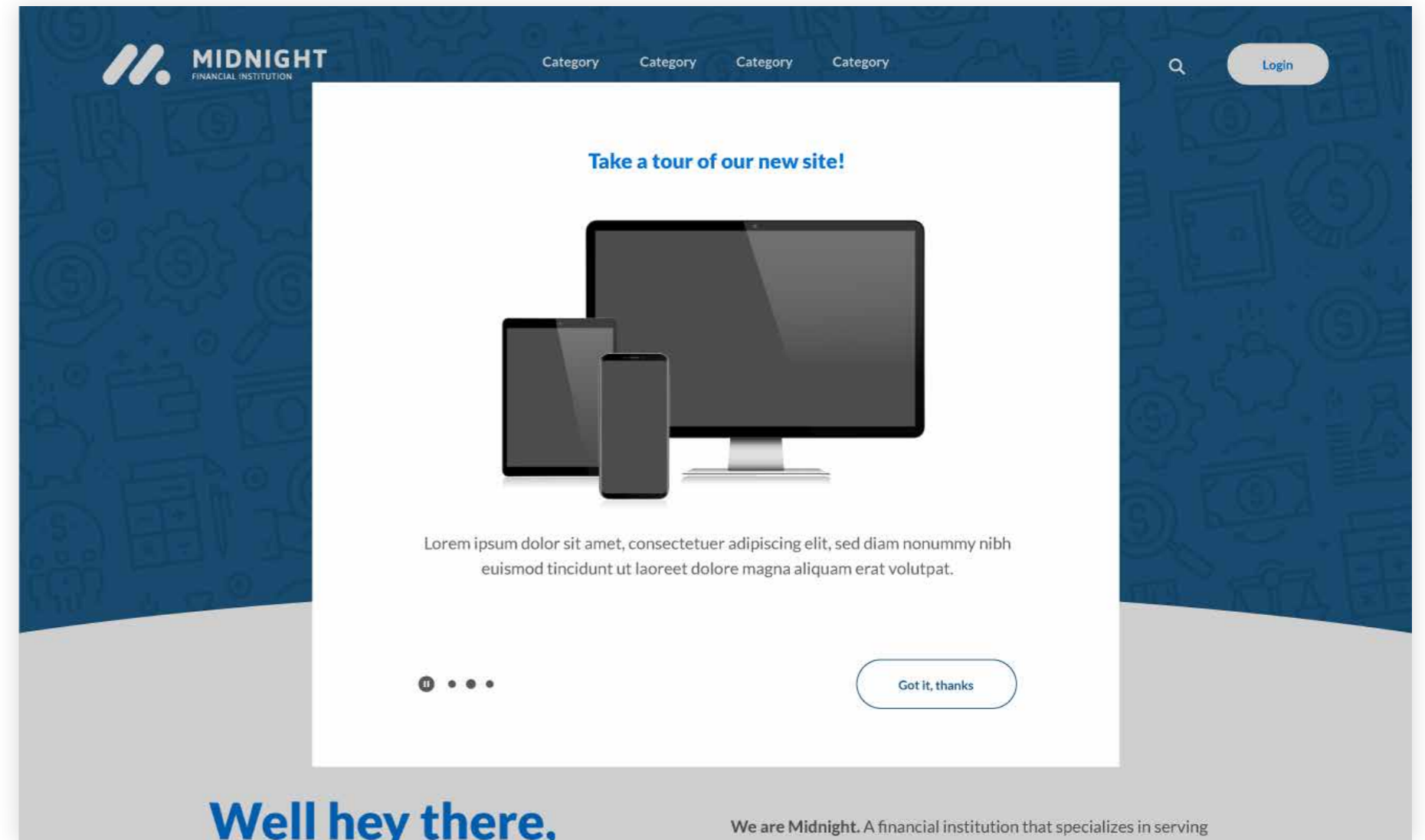
A modal to promote and educate customers on the new site immediately following launch. This will help show and organize new additions to the site as well as help your users navigate the new web experience.

Once the site is past launch, this will remain on the site as an option for future use. This can be utilized as a high-priority alert, ad area, or a space to promote limited deals that an FI wants customers to see immediately upon visiting the site.

Page

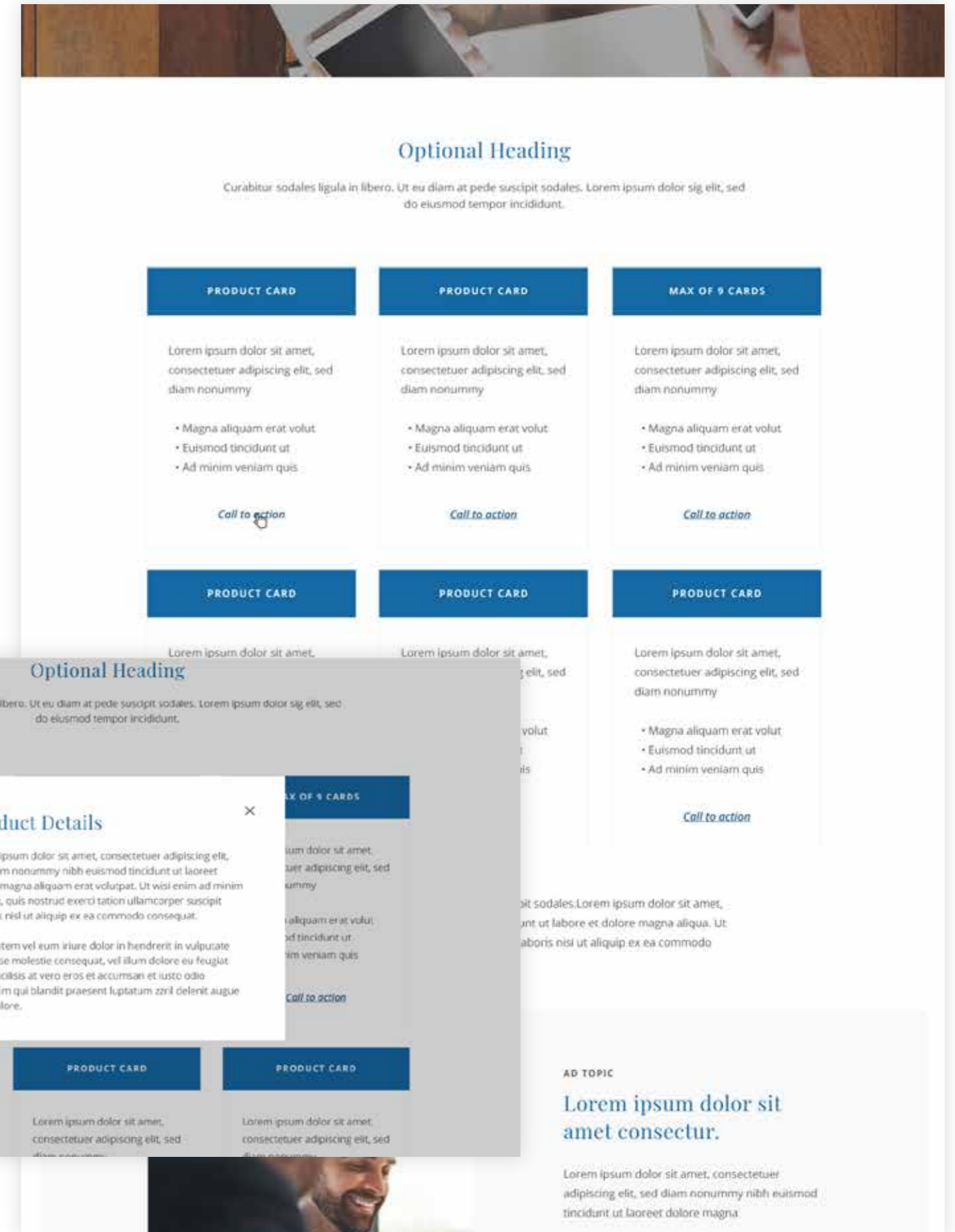
A component that will be used for comparing different products. Typically seen on a checking or savings page. This is the easiest way to compare products on a mobile device. The Cards are great to show the highlights on each product, then using the modal for the full description.

Branch

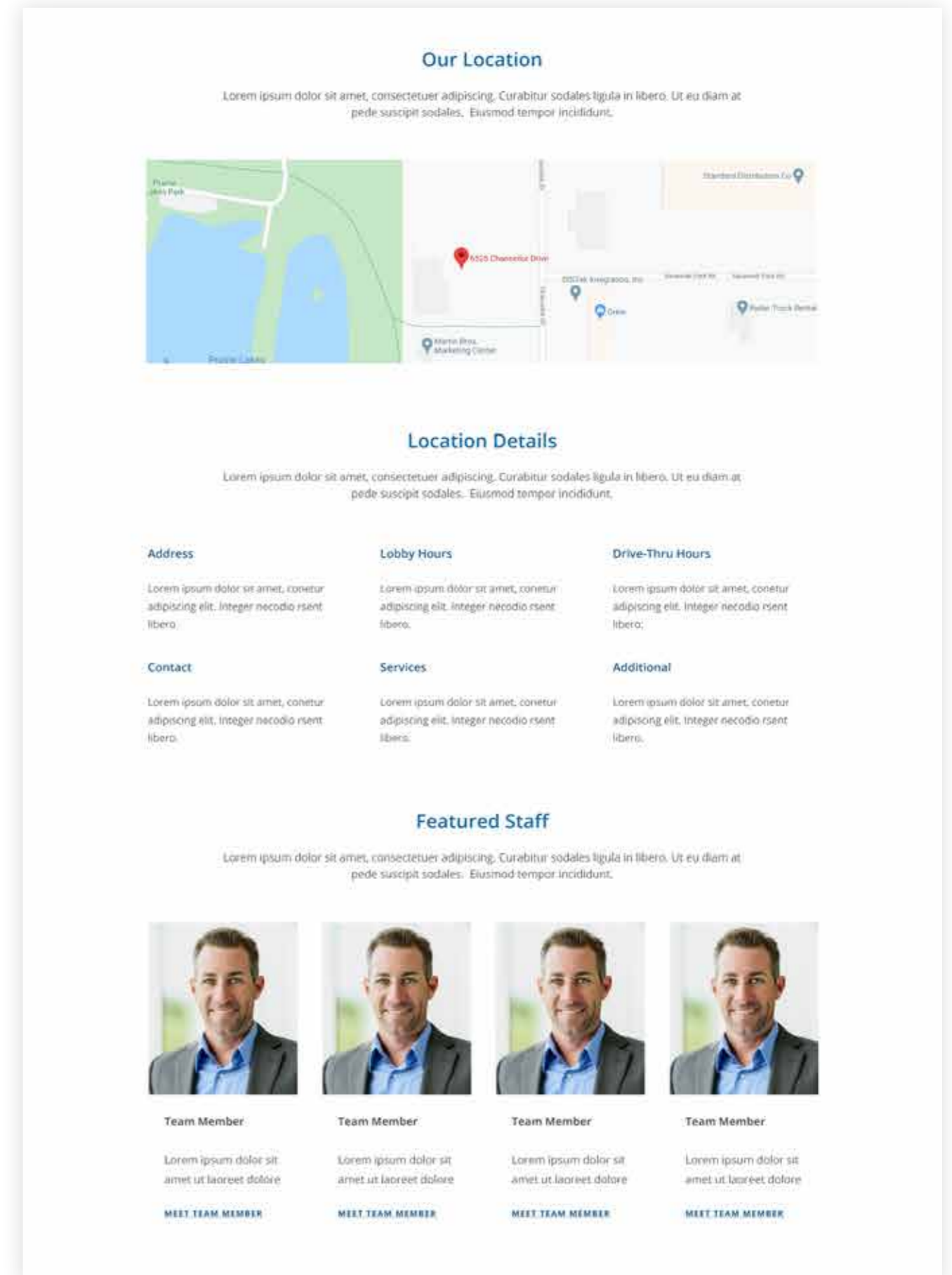
Grouping & Page

Cell, Grouping & Page

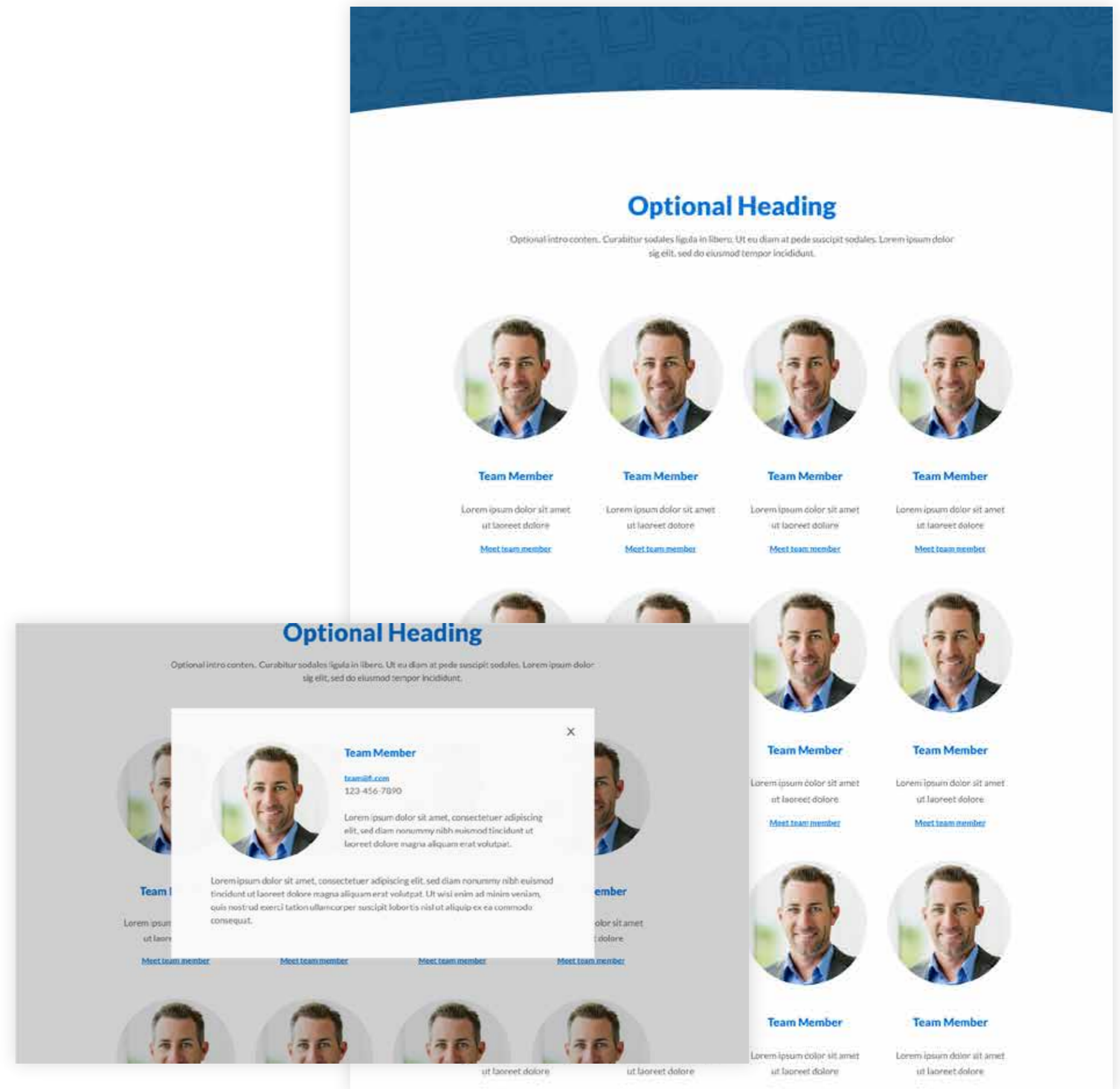

We have designed cells with specialists in mind that you may want to appear on a specific page, groupings that is used for a small team to appear on a specific page, and then entire page to organize teams in one layout. Great to display job titles and contact info.

- Page has max 36 team members
- Optional modals include areas for a photo and brief bio
- Group has max of 4 team members

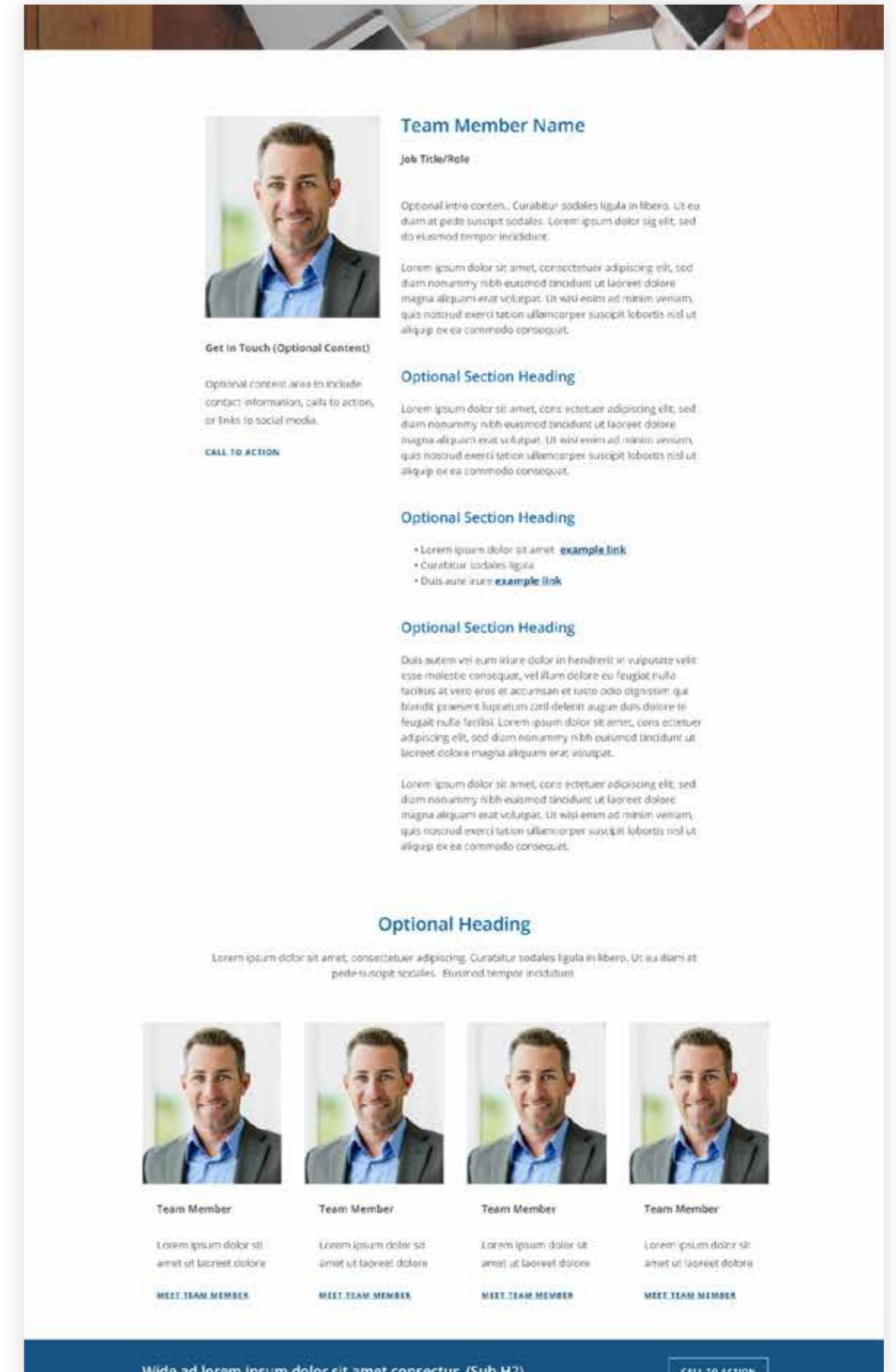

FAQ

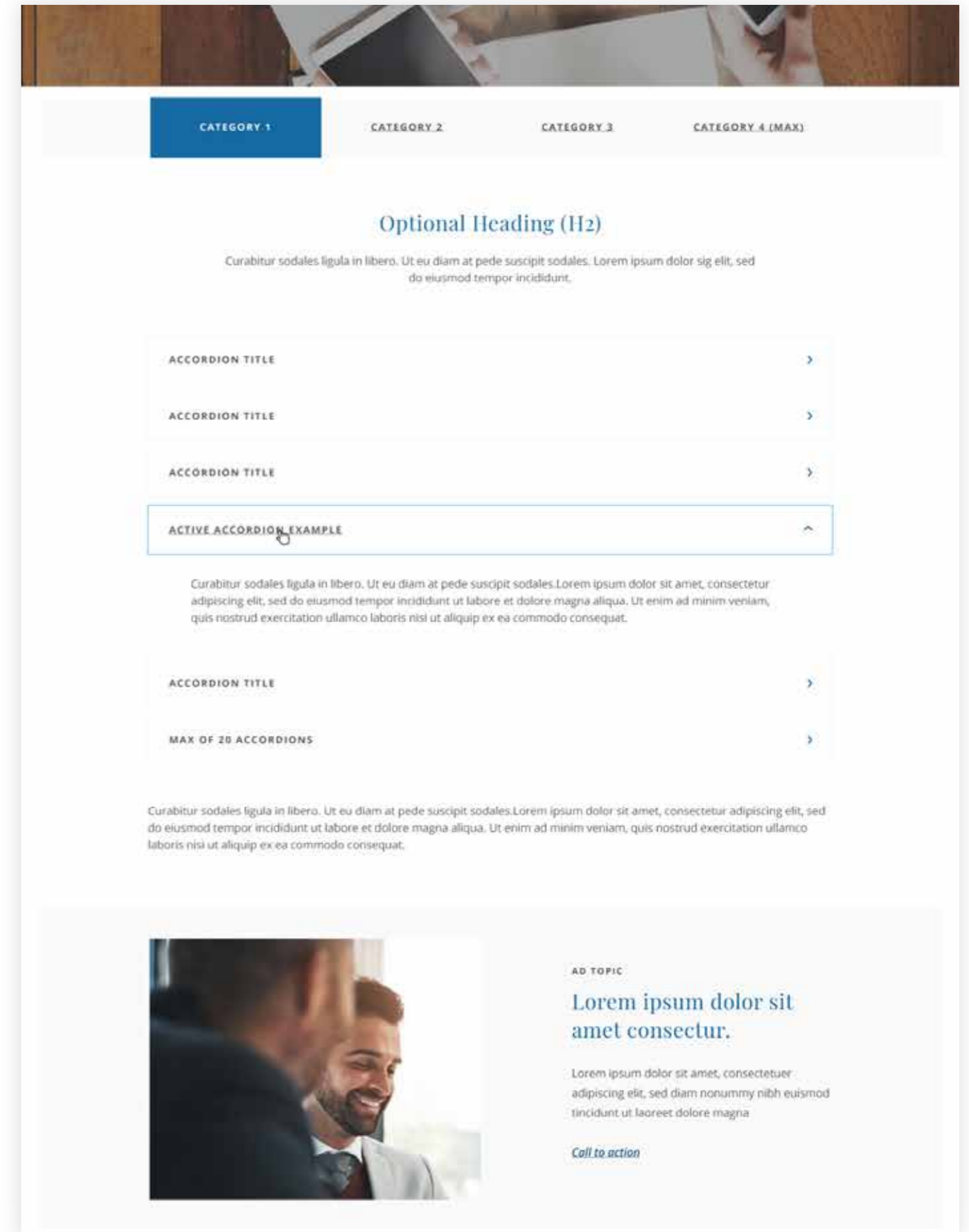
Page

An easy-to-use layout designed to organize frequently asked questions. This layout has a max of four categories to give order to FI topics and information. Within each category there are up to 20 accordions available for Q&A purposes. The accordion title can be used for the question/topic; the expanded content area can be used for brief or elaborate explanations with the ability to link to other pages, if desired.

News/Resources

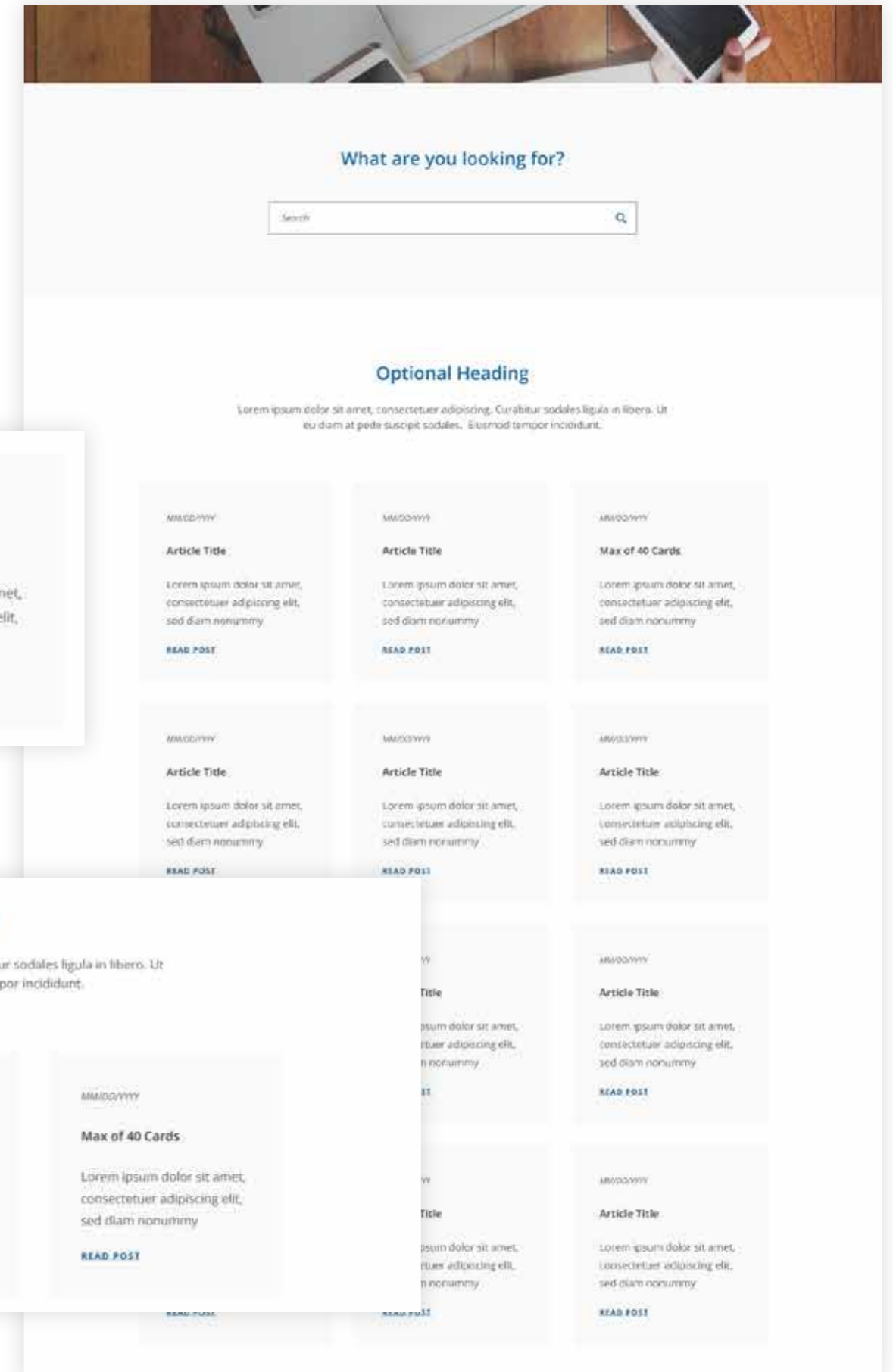
Cell, Grouping & Page

This component is used for news and/or events. This component has the ability for searching within the page contents. With that functionality, this layout has many uses. Great for organizing articles and resources. These “cards” will reorder by the date entered within the designated content area.

- Max 40 cards per layout
- Search Input field
- Ordered by date

Blog

Cell, Grouping, Page, & Article Page

The largest of the components, the blog is used for organizing blog posts. The layout page is used as a hub to show and organize the individual posts. This layout features a max of 4 category tabs, each tab shows max of 15 blog posts. The page layout can include up to 12 accordions for archiving purposes. Additionally, we have included an article page that is specifically designed and organized for easy reading.

- Max of 4 categories
- Max 15 blog posts per category
- Ordered by date
- Max 12 accordions
